

**Report on  
Stakeholder Dialogue: Seminar on Establishing National Public Council on Migration**

**January 25, 2013, Kashkasuu, Kyrgyzstan**

The Seminar was held within the Stakeholder Dialogue activities of the TSPC project on “Protecting the Rights of Kyrgyz and other Central Asian Migrants: Utilizing policy analysis, public outreach, and stakeholder dialogue to mobilize action toward reform”. The seminar was co-organized by the “Resource Center for Elderly” Public Association.

The Seminar was organized with the aim to develop projection and plan for the new National Public Council on Migration in KR. The participants were supposed to develop plan and schedule of activities, as well as plan the licensing procedures of the Council.
